



## 2026 SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA FRAUD INVESTIGATORS' ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE SPEAKER APPLICATION AND GUIDELINES

The Southern California Fraud Investigators' Association (SCFIA) aims to heighten fraud investigators' knowledge of ongoing fraudulent activities, provide a forum for information exchange, improve methods for eliminating crime involving fraud, and foster good fellowship among members. We are currently seeking speakers for our Annual Anti-Fraud Conference taking place November 3rd through 5th, 2026 in a wide variety of topics that are geared towards the specific needs of our members at our conference. Requests to present at the SCFIA Conference be reviewed by the SCFIA Speaker Committee. Sessions may be limited to 60 minutes for individual speakers and 90 to 120 minutes for panel presentations; however, depending on the topic and/or depth, those time frames may be amended.

All proposed speakers must submit a bio, including prior speaking engagements, along with this Application.

### Selection Criteria

Proposals will be selected based on the following:

- Topic is innovative, current, cutting edge, engaging and relevant to claims administrators, adjusters, SIU's, private investigators and attorneys in the detection, investigations, civil/administrative defense, and prosecution of fraudulent insurance claims
- Proposal contains specific "take-aways" for the audience that will improve their abilities to detect insurance fraud
- Speaker(s) is/are passionate about the topic
- Topics are eligible for POST and/or continuing education credits for attorneys and insurance professionals
- Preference may be given to speakers who are members of SCFIA

Speakers must conform to the following guidelines:

- Refrain from any direct marketing of a product or service during the presentation and in the presentation slides
- Provide content by the print deadlines, which will be provided upon selection of the topic
